**DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION**

This filing is made pursuant to FCC Part 61.39 rules. Union Telephone Company (“Union”) is a small, local exchange carrier which serves less than 50,000 access lines and is a subset 3 carrier as defined by FCC Part 69.602. Union’s last tariff change was submitted on June 17, 2002 with an effective date of July 2, 2002<sup>i</sup> and pursuant MAG Access Charge Tariff filings, CCB/CPD01-23 issued December 17, 2001, effective January 1, 2002. With this filing, Union proposes to modify both traffic sensitive switched and special access rates as dictated by changes in both cost and demand, with no proposed modifications to any non-recurring charges or additional labor rates. Additionally, this filing removes Carrier Common Line Access Service text from Section 3 and the Table of Contents of this tariff.

Pursuant to MAG Access Charge Tariff Filings, CCB/CPD 01-23, Union has filed to increase its Issuing Carrier’s residential and single-line Subscriber Line Charges (SLC) to \$6.50 per line.

Union files under section 61.39 of the Commission’s rules and, as such, has submitted no detailed cost support with this filing. Union has and will continue to make this information available to interested parties upon reasonable request. The cost support attached to this filing includes a discussion of the methodologies employed in developing these rates.
