*Proposed TXU Communications Companies Access Service Tariff
F.C.C. No. 1 which consolidates the interstate access and special
construction tariffs of the 2 affiliated companies, TXU Communications
Telephone Company and Ft. Bend Telephone Company*

This filing is made in accordance with Special Permission No. 04-004, filed January 6, 2004.

The accompanying tariff material, issued by the TXU Communications Companies (TXUCC; FRN #0010-1553-98), consisting of TXU Communications Telephone Company (TXUC) and Ft. Bend Telephone Company (FBTC), and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. The effective date of February 7, 2004, is exactly fifteen days after the filing date, in accordance with Section 204(a)(3) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Additionally being sent to you for filing, are the Title Page and Supplement No. 1 for TXU Communications Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service, and TXU Communications Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Special Construction, canceling these tariffs on the effective date of TXUCC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. In addition, under separate transmittal, John Staurulakis, Inc., in whose tariff FBTC is an issuing carrier, will be filing to end FBTC's status as an issuing carrier, effective the same day.

TXUCC Tariff FCC No. 1 will carry forward the rates found in the existing Fort Bend Telephone Company interstate access tariff (JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1) and TXUC Telephone Company Tariff FCC No. 1, along with regulations found in TXUC Telephone Company Tariffs FCC No. 1 and No. 2, without material change. Granting this application will reduce the administrative burden of the companies' customers and of the Commission staff by reducing the number of tariffs requiring administration, eliminating unnecessary blank pages and sequentially renumbering each tariff section.

This transmittal letter and the supporting documents are being electronically filed today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (EFTS).

In addition to the tariff pages being filed, a side-by-side comparison of the original and new consolidated tariff is being provided for comparison purposes. The tariffs and supporting documents being filed consist of the following:
