DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

This filing is being made by GVNW Consulting, Inc¹ (GVNW) on behalf of its issuing carriers LaHarpe Telephone Company (LaHarpe), Madison Telephone Company (Madison), McNabb Telephone Company (McNabb) and McDonough Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (McDonough) for GVNW Inc./Management Tariff F.C.C. No. 2. These companies are local exchange carriers (LEC), which serve fewer than 50,000 access lines. They are subset 3 carriers as defined by the Commission's rules under Section 69.602.^{2,3}

LaHarpe and McDonough propose to offer Ethernet-based UNI or NNI port speed options under DSL Access Connection Service for McDonough Telephone Cooperative, Inc (Section 12.8.3(H)) and LaHarpe Telephone Company (Section 12.13.3(G)). Therefore, GVNW proposes adding Ethernet service to its DSL Access Service Connection, ADSL Service Rate Element language in GVNW Inc./Management Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 in Section 7.

Madison proposes to replace ADSL retail service with its ADSL Wholesale Rate Plans (WRP) and add a 44.736 Mbps connection to its DSL Access Service Connection

service. All of Madison's current ADSL end users have signed up with the Internet Service Provider and will switch to the proposed lower rates. GVNW also proposes adding language in GVNW Inc./Management Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 in Section 7 to add an additional ADSL Term Rate Plan (TRP) of five years. These companies file rates under Section 61.39 of the Commission's rules. Pursuant to Section 61.39, GVNW has not submitted detailed cost support with this filing for these companies. As it has done in the past, GVNW will make cost support information available, on behalf of these companies to interested parties upon request.

This filing also restates McNabb Telephone Company as an Issuing Carrier, which was removed in error in a previous filing.
