**Re: Application for Special Permission**

To the Commission:

Application for Special Permission is hereby made on behalf of Valor Telecommunications Enterprises, LLC ("Valor"), to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 61.58 and 61.59 (2003), to withdraw, on same day's notice, proposed tariff revisions originally filed on October 1, 2004, under Transmittal No. 43. Specifically, Valor seeks to reinstate pages 8-5, 8-10 through 8-10.1, 8-11, 8-12, and 20-137 and to re-file those pages with a corrected notice period. As this application would correct the notice period for the proposed revisions, good cause exists to grant this application.

Valor requires a waiver of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to permit it to make revisions to tariff materials that have not yet become effective. It is in the public interest for the Commission to grant this waiver in order to ensure that customers do not experience multiple revisions within a thirty-day period. Copies of illustrative pages are attached.

This filing has been submitted electronically through the Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System ("ETFS"), in accordance with Section 61.13(b) of the Commission's rules and regulations. 47 C.F.R. § 61.13(b) (2003).
