- 1) With this transmittal, Verizon is proposing the following revisions to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 11:
 - Miscellaneous typographical errors in Sections 2 (General Regulations), 7 (Special Access Service) and 15 (Operating Territory and Metropolitan Statistical Areas of the Verizon Telephone Companies) are corrected.
 - General channel type descriptions are added for several Special Access Services which were inadvertently omitted when those services were introduced.

- Certain regulations pertaining to Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) are revised to include the introduction of the Elmira County MSA, alphabetize the list of MSAs, correct various Common Language Location Identification codes for wire centers within several MSAs, and remove a duplicate MSA.

Support material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing.

- 2) This filing also provides for Special Construction of facilities to provision tariffed services in Tariff FCC No. 21 for the following:

VA – Telvista, XO Communications; NY – E&M ESR, Inc.; TX – MCI, AT&T.

Also several cases have been deleted as the contracts have been cancelled, a typographical error corrected, and a move to correct a company code being assigned incorrectly in an earlier filing.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.38 of the Commission’s Rules is included with this filing.
