With this filing, Verizon is expanding the availability of Asynchronous Transfer Mode Cell Relay Service (ATM CRS) offered in Part II, Section 5.10, to include customers in the State of Nevada. ATM CRS is a telecommunications transport and switching service that provides for high-speed connectivity between customer designated locations.

ATM CRS is an interstate special access service utilizing category 1.2 facilities, as defined in Section 36.154, and is not a "loop-based" service per the definition in paragraph 61.3(yy) of the Commission's Rules. Therefore, pursuant to paragraph 61.49(f)(3), the new services associated with this filing are being filed without cost support.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
