Dear Ms. Salas:

The accompanying tariff material issued by the Wamego Telephone Company, Inc. and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, effective July 3, 2001, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Effective July 3, 2001, Wamego Telephone Company, Inc. is canceling its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 in its entirety. Instead of issuing and maintaining its own tariff for interstate access services, Wamego Telephone Company will thereafter be a participating carrier in National Exchange Carrier Association ("NECA") Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. The rates, terms and conditions of Wamego Telephone Company, Inc.'s interstate access tariff will thereafter be found in the NECA tariff.

As required by Section 61.32 of the Rules, the original of this transmittal letter, plus the Commission's filing fee of six hundred and fifty-five dollars (\$655.00) for tariff filings, is being sent via overnight delivery to Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, PA, as of this date.
