With this filing, SWBT is proposing to introduce a rate increase for 1+ Saver direct service into the F.C.C. No.67 Interstate/IntraLATA Message Telecommunications Service Tariff. In addition SWBT proposes to introduce the new TOLL VALUE Block of Time (BOT) plan that replaces the service of Local Plus for the state of Missouri, into it's F.C.C. No. 67 tariff. TOLL VALUE BOT Plans are optional one-way outbound services that offer subscriber's a local calling scope to all rate centers within the customer's LATA.
