DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

1. INTRODUCTION

In Transmittal No. 21, ACS of Anchorage, Inc. ("ACS-ANC"), proposes to revise its tariff to state that Unbundled Network Elements ("UNEs") and combinations of UNEs can be commingled with wholesale services, including interstate access services.

2. DESCRIPTION

ACS-ANC files this revision in accordance the Commission's Report and Order and Order on Remand and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, CC Docket No. 01-338, paragraph 581, released August 21, 2003. In this Order, the Commission concluded that the Act does not prohibit the commingling of UNEs and wholesale services and that section 251(c)(3) of the Act grants authority for the Commission to adopt rules to permit the commingling of UNEs and combinations of UNEs with wholesale services, including interstate access services.

In accordance with the above conclusion, ACS-ANC files revisions to F.C.C. Tariff No. 1 Section 1 to state that Unbundled Network Elements and combinations of UNEs can be commingled with wholesale services, including interstate access services. Additionally, Section 2 is being modified to add definitions for Commingling and UNEs.
