

**PACIFIC BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY  
DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

**PURPOSE**

With this filing, Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) is proposing to change its IntraLATA Wholesale Service (IWS) to exclude casual dialed IntraLATA toll calls (101XXXX+1) and add 0+ Collect calls and 0+ Billed to Third party IntraLATA calls to the offering. In addition, an IWS network charge for the initial order is being added.

**DESCRIPTION**

Effective with this filing, IWS will no longer allow customers to route their casual dialed IntraLATA toll calls (101XXXX+1) over the Telephone Company's existing IWS network. IWS will allow 0+ Collect calls and 0+ Billed to Third party IntraLATA calls to route over the Telephone Company's network in addition to the 1+ traffic currently routed and will be completed by the Telephone Company. The IWS customer will not be charged the minute of use (MOU) for 0+ Collect calls or 0+ Billed to third Party IntraLATA calls and the revenue for these calls will be collected by the Telephone Company. Miscellaneous text changes, additions, and deletions were made in order to clarify the service offering and ordering process.

The new IWS Network Charge is a nonrecurring charge that will be applied to any initial IWS order prospectively. This charge covers the establishment and

removal of IWS functionality in all Telephone Company end offices for which service is ordered.
