1. Existing Interstate IntraLATA optional calling plans that must be ordered in conjunction with Intrastate IntraLATA calling plans are moved to a new Generic Optional Calling Plan section.
2. Local Package Basic and Local Package Plus are being introduced for the state of Connecticut. Both Local Package Basic and Local Package Plus are generic optional calling plans for residence Dial Station customers.
