On October 15, 2004, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 502, which made corrections to Tariff FCC No. 11 Section 15, Operating Territory and Metropolitan Statistical Areas of the Verizon Telephone Companies. On 1st Revised Page 15-21 submitted under Transmittal No. 502, Verizon was correcting a typographical error to the Common Language Location Identifier ("CLLI") for one of the wire centers within the New York NY Metropolitan Statistical Area ("MSA"). Verizon has since realized that in lieu of correcting that CLLI, the CLLI should have been removed since it is actually a duplicate CLLI for that same wire center within the New York NY MSA.

Under authority of Special Permission No. 04-071 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to delete the duplicate CLLI.

Support material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing.
