8. Caption (description of authority requested, e.g., Application for Authority to Provide International Facilities–Based and Resold Services to All International Points Except Country X)

Paramtel Communications, Inc. ('Paramtel') hereby requests authority of the Communications Act of 1934, as ammended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Sections 63.18, to provide international facilities based and resale services between the United States and international points. Paramtel is a new U.S. company organized to provide international telecommunication services. Paramtel has no foreign affiliations. Paramtel serves business cutomers throughout the United States. By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Paramtel.
